Sketch Portrait as the name suggests, is a minature. It was composed in Melbourne in 1983. The restricted dynamic range and gentle rhythms are a contrast to my previous large scale essay for the piano, the 1979 *Sonata*.

The work is a study in subtle inflections of sonority. This is achieved by limiting the harmonic movement to within sonorities which exhibit maximal interal class similarity. The listener may detect a similarity in mood to Erik Satie's *Gymnopédies*.
